

Home – School Agreement (School Copy)

- Keep pupils safe.
- Set high standards of behaviour.
- Keep parents informed about pupils' progress and achievements.
- Nurture the partnership with parents/ carers and the wider community.
- Keep parents informed about school events.
- Provide guidelines for how to support learning at home.
- Discuss with parents any concerns regarding their child.

Home will:

- Ensure regular attendance and punctuality.
- Inform the school on the first morning of the child's absence and update as necessary.
- Take an active and supportive interest in their child's learning and school related activities, e.g. homework, reading and spellings.
- Support the school's behaviour policies.
- Respect the school's dress code and ensure their child has all necessary items for the day, e.g. PE kit, coat, water bottle.
- Attend parent consultations.
- Keep the school informed about any concerns regarding their child. Update contact details if changes occur.
