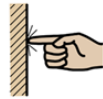

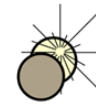

	object	A material thing that can be seen or touched.
	material	Materials are the matter or substance that an object is made of.
	water	A colourless, odourless, transparent liquid.
	rock	A solid, mineral material.
	stretchy	Can be easily stretched, flexible and go back to its normal shape.
	waterproof	Something that keeps water out, and water cannot pass through.
	absorbent	A material that can soak up liquid.
	rough	Not smooth or even.
	smooth	A material with an even and regular surface.
	texture	How something feels when it is touched.
