Vertebrates	Animals with a backbone. Fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds, and mammals, including humans, are all vertebrates.
Insect	A small animal that has six legs and generally one or two pairs of wings
Invertebrates	Animals that don't have a backbone, such as worms, slugs, spiders and crustaceans.
Human impact	Changes that have taken place as a result of the actions of humans.
