





	Vertebrates	Animals with a backbone, Fish, Amphibians, Reptiles, Birds and Mammals, including humans are all vertebrates.
	Insect	A small animal that has six legs and generally one or two pairs of wings.
	Invertebrates	Animals that don't have a backbone, such as worms, slugs, spiders and crustaceans.
	Human Impact	Changes that have taken place as a result of the actions of humans.
	Classification keys	A series of questions that, when answered, tell us about an organism's physical characteristics.
