## Key Vocabulary

<b>county</b>	a region within a country, such as Cornwall.
<b>peninsula</b>	a piece of land almost surrounded by water.
<b>tourism</b>	when people travel from where they live to another place for fun and relaxation.
<b>destination</b>	the place to which a person is going or goods are sent.
<b>landmark</b>	a feature of a landscape that is easily seen or recognised.
<b>biome</b>	an area of land with a particular climate, type of plants and animals.
<b>climate</b>	the general weather conditions and patterns in an area.
<b>moor</b>	an area of open land with poor soil covered mainly with grass and heather.
<b>estuary</b>	an area where a freshwater river or stream meets the ocean.
