Staffing & Leadership News

Since having children, Miss Bridson has returned on a part-time basis providing planning and preparation cover for teachers across the school and she has also made a significant contribution to designing and developing our computing and online safety curriculums as Computing Lead. Term 5's Leadership Arrangements
