### Things to remember when collecting

- It is fine to collect natural things that you find on the ground that are no longer living – such as fallen leaves, flakes of bark, feathers, empty snail shells and twigs.
- Never uproot a plant. Take a photo or make a sketch instead.
- Avoid trespassing on private land or picking a plant from nature reserves and protected areas.
- Only ever pick part of a plant and only if it is from a large patch of common species (such as daisies or dandelions).
- Be aware that some berries and toadstools are poisonous! Don't pick – take a photo.
