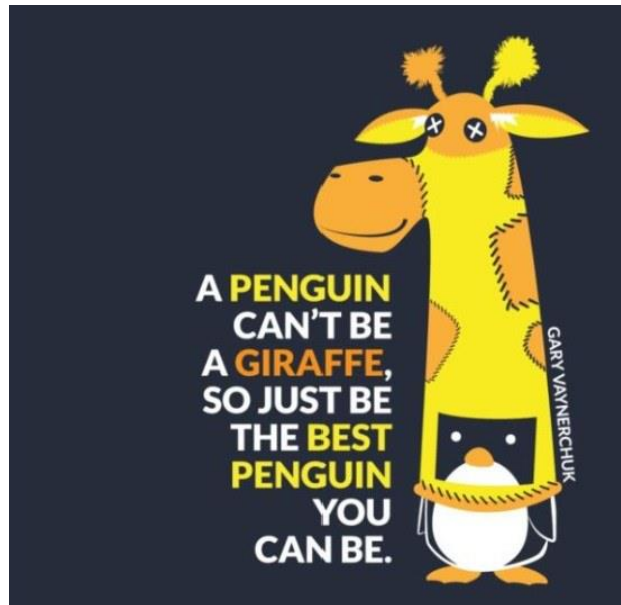

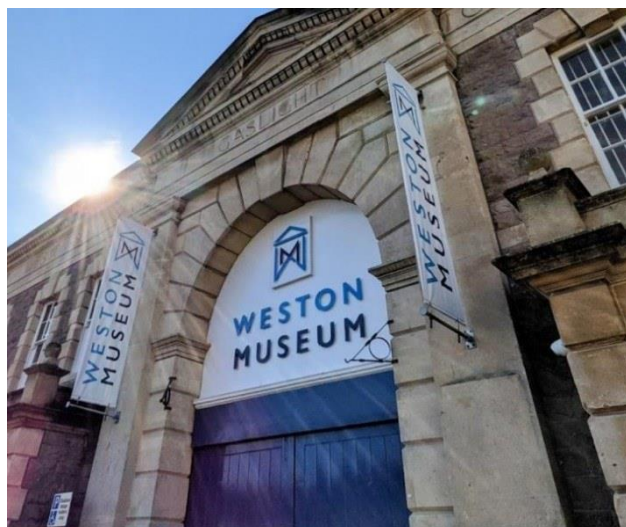
Congratulations Hadley!
