The Whiteoak Academies Pupil Enrichment & Curriculum Fund

As a school, we fully recognise the importance of broad and varied experiences for our children. Therefore, in order to allow us to continue to enhance and enrich the curriculum for our children, we have created a voluntary Pupil Enrichment & Curriculum Fund.

Examples of how this fund was used last year include: the purchase of ingredients for cooking, new musical instruments in KS1 & KS2, music and scripts for assemblies and plays, materials for science lessons and Forest School and specialist art & DT materials and resources. Furthermore, our Pupil Enrichment & Curriculum Fund was used to enable the school to bring in some specialist teachers for whole class provision such as musical instrument tuition, online plays and lessons, local educational visits to the Tithe Barn and much, much more!
